DUTIES

Administrative - Data Entry

- Sort and process patient specimens received from doctor's offices, specialists, and
- walk-in clinics etc.
- Enter new orders for microbiology patient specimens, edit, delete, and cancel existing orders that have not been resulted.
- Communicate with co-workers and other departments, clinics and physicians when troubleshooting problem samples



Bench Duties Bacteriology

- Correctly use and clean biological safety cabinets. Record airflow readings.
- Select proper media for various sample types and use proper technique for streaking plates to set up: respiratory, wound, and genital swabs, sputum, urine, and stool specimens for bacterial culture
- Prepare and stain slides for microscopic examination. Perform Gram stain procedure and run controls
- Incubate cultures as required
- Parasitology
- Set up and process stool specimens for microscopic examination for intestinal ova and parasites
- Prepare concentrates.
- Correctly use and clean centrifuges
- Stain and mount permanent slides. Perform Trichrome stain procedure.
- Prepare pinworm swabs for microscopic examination.
- Prepare and stain slides for Cryptosporidium/Cyclospora. Perform Auramine-O stain procedure.

Miscellaneous Duties

- Correctly use, clean, and maintain automated Gram stain analyzer
- Clean water carboy
- Dispose of biohazard material
- Prepare solutions/reagents and collection kits as required
- Maintain eye wash station
- Surface disinfection
