Update to SHBG testing – British Columbia

Audience

All healthcare providers who order Sex hormone-binding globulin (SHBG).

Overview

The Dynacare vision is to be Canada's health and wellness solutions leader. Effective September 15, 2025, Dynacare will offer SHBG testing as a standalone test, in addition to when ordered with bioavailable testosterone.

Details

Sex hormone-binding globulin (SHBG) binds to sex hormones and is used in the investigation of hormonal imbalances in males and females. SHBG will be orderable as a stand alone, patient pay test. If bioavailable testosterone is ordered, Medical Services Plan (MSP) funding for SHBG will be provided only for adult males (>18 yrs), whose total testosterone falls between 3-8 nmol/L and 30-35 nmol/L. For patients who do not qualify for MSP funding, but still require a result for bioavailable testosterone, testing is available through private pay.
