Changes to CBC Instrumentation – British Columbia

Audience

Healthcare Providers requesting CBC testing in British Columbia.

Overview

The complete blood count (CBC) is a commonly ordered blood test that assesses the cells in your blood providing a comprehensive overview of your overall health.

Dynacare's vision is to be Canada's health and wellness solutions leader. Effective May 25, 2026, Dynacare will be updating the instrumentation for CBC testing.

Details

CBC instrumentation is changing from Sysmex XN-2000 to Beckman Coulter DxH900 instruments.

As part of this transition, immature granulocytes will no longer be included in the differential count. Health care providers can expect reports to reflect a standard 5-part differential.

Action Required

No action is required. Reporting format and reference ranges remain the same.
